It was during this time that Travis gave his life to Christ. "I let Christ take the reigns, and boy did He ever take control," stated Travis. After graduating our 6 month program, Travis was sentenced on all of his charges. He appeared at court before the judge and waited for the verdict. "God showed up that day in that court room, and He didn't hide His presence at all!" Travis exclaimed. God showed His grace that day to Travis in a big way. For all of his charges he was sentenced to 17 years, all suspended, with 5 years of probation, and a small time on house arrest. Praise the Lord for His amazing grace and transforming work in Travis' life! Travis now works for The Lighthouse as our 30 day program Resident Manager.
